


ATD Fourth World New Mexico Participatory Planning Proces

After the 10th anniversary of the Story Garden at the Gallup flea market in 2022, members of ATD Fourth World in New Mexico felt ready to embark on a major planning exercise. Our goal was to build on the initial learning phase from 2019 to 2021, during which we learned deeply from the families we work alongside. During the planning phase, we created spaces for collective thinking which engaged community members in defining our goals and actions.

Outcome of the process: 2-year plan 2023-2025

The questions and reflections that emerged in the gatherings during the planning process allowed us to explore our identity as ATD Fourth World in New Mexico, our place as members in supporting ATD's efforts, and importantly, shape our programs' evolution. This resulted in three main areas of action for the next 2 years:


Presence and Learning with Families in Poverty




Membership Base and Capacity Building



Education and Art Initiatives




Voices from our Community Participatory Planning Process, March 2023



"The element important to me is forming alliances with the people connected to ATD."




"It's empowering for kids when they have a platform to express their voice. It's good for everyone because kids tell the truth."


